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H.H. Dudjom Rinpoche

We have a number of rare videos of H.H. Dudjom Rinpoche that were recorded during his 1980 visit to Pacific Region Yeshe Nyingpo in California, and Orgyen Chö Dzong in Greenville, New York. The translator in all of the videos is Tulku Pema Wangyal.

The Black Crown Ceremony (VDR1)

H.H. XVI Gyalwa Karmapa, H.H. Dudjom Rinpoche, and Venerable Gyatrul Rinpoche together at the Bay Area Yeshe Nyingpo Center, July 14, 1980. Footage begins with the arrival of H.H. Karmapa, accompanied by the late H.E. Jamgon Kongtrul Rinpoche. Includes informal shots of the lamas at lunch. Also includes a portion of the *Black Crown Ceremony*. (1 DVD/20 min)

The Bodhisattva Vow Ceremony (VDR2)

H.H. Dudjom Rinpoche confers the bodhisattva vows and gives a teaching on bodhichitta and the practice of the bodhisattvas. To conclude, he leads the assembly in the practice of the short *Dudjom Tersar Ngöndro*. Bay Area Yeshe Nyingpo, June 17, 1980. (1 DVD/1 hr, 35 min)

The Empowerment of One Thousand Buddhas (VDR3)

H.H. Dudjom Rinpoche gives empowerment; Tulku Pema Wangyal translates. Oakland Auditorium. July 6, 1980. (1 DVD/1 hr, 20 min)

Tara Empowerment (VDR4)

H.H. Dudjom Rinpoche gives empowerment for the practice of White Tara; Tulku Pema Wangyal translates. Fort Mason, San Francisco, California. May 31, 1980. (1 DVD/1 hr, 30 min)

Dzogchen Seminar (VDR5)

H.H. Dudjom Rinpoche teaches on the Dzogchen view and practice, Tulku Pema Wangyal translates. His Holiness gives meditation instruction, and then sits in meditation with the assembly. Bay Area Yeshe Nyingpo, July 5, 1980. (1 DVD/2 hrs, 5 min)

Death, Dying, and Meditation (VDR6)

H.H. Dudjom Rinpoche gives a Padmasambhava empowerment and instruction on the phowa practice to be done at the time of death. This video also includes footage of the Venerable Gyatrul Rinpoche and H.E. Chagdud Rinpoche. Eugene, Oregon, November 1980. (4 DVDs/7 hrs, 30 min)

The Fundamentals: An Explanation of the Nine Vehicles (VDR7)

H.H. Dudjom Rinpoche gave this teaching on the nine yanas in a retreat atmosphere; students received instructions and practiced techniques with him. Tulku Pema Wangyal translates. Orgyen Chö Dzong, Greenville, New York, Autumn 1980. (7 DVDs/13 hrs, 20 min)

Vajrasattva (Dorje Sempa) Empowerment (VDR8)

H.H. Dudjom Rinpoche performs the preparatory puja for of the empowerment, chanting and playing the cymbals, accompanied by his son, Shenphen Dawa Rinpoche. His Holiness then gives the refuge vows, the Vajrasattva empowerment, and confers blessings. Scott Hall, San Anselmo, California, 1980. (1 DVD/2 hrs, 5 min)

Yeshe Tsogyal Puja (VDR9)

H.H. Dudjom Rinpoche leads the Yeshe Tsogyal sadhana, and then gives a brief commentary. Tulku Pema Wangyal translates. Greenville, New York, 1980. (1 DVD/1 hr, 25 min)

Visit to Bay Area (VDR10)

This is, essentially, a “home movie.” There were no microphones used, so the sound quality is poor, and in some places, inaudible. H.H. Dudjom Rinpoche arrives with his family, and then blesses a long line of Western disciples (this was the last time H.H. performed such a public blessing in the U.S.). The video concludes with His Holiness giving a brief long-life blessing at the home of Professor Lin. Autumn 1984. (1 DVD/2 hrs, 5 min)

Practice Tersar Ngöndro with His Holiness (VDR11)

H.H. Penor Rinpoche / Palyul Monks

Lama Dances (VPR1)

During the Kama empowerments bestowed by H.H. Penor Rinpoche in the summer of 1988 at Tashi Chöling Retreat Center, Ashland, Oregon, the Palyul monks performed a number of lama dances. This DVD includes the *Snow Lion Dance of Auspiciousness*, *Dakini Dance of Peace*, *Deer Dance of Subjugation*, the Nam Chö tradition *Black Hat Offering Dance of the Remains*, the Dorje Drak tradition *Offering Dance of the Remains to Befriend the Yogins and Yoginis of the Secret Mandala*, the *Dance of the Golden Drink*. It ends with footage of lama dances performed at H.H. Penor Rinpoche’s monastery in Byalakuppe, India, recorded during the 1986 Gutor ceremony: H.H. Torma Making I (VPR4)

Torma Making II (VPR5)

Long-life Blessing and Empowerment (VPR6)

In a public event, H.H. Penor Rinpoche gives the long-life empowerment of Jatsön Nyingpo and a brief teaching on practices and methods for healing and life-extension. Khenpo Namdröl gives a brief history of the Nyingmapa which was recorded for broadcast on the Voice of America. The event concludes with a short lama dance. Washington, D.C., June 1995. Guru Yoga Teaching (VPR7)

Authentic Practice (VGR10) [R]
